Later, you'll board the Azamara Quest in time for a late lunch before sailing out at 6pm - the perfect way to visit Quebec and Eastern Canada! Today onboard the **Quest** is the perfect time to experience everything your boutique hotel at sea offers - or simply do nothing at all! The small town of Gaspé, renowned for its delicious seafood cafes, also provides a perfect gateway to stunningly woodsy **Forillon National Park**, and offers outdoor enthusiasts opportunities for hiking and whale watching. September 16, 2025 - Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island
You'll dock at 10am in Charlottetown, striking a perfect balance that
pairs small town charm with big city energy. With its romantic
streetscapes, stunning water vistas and sun-dappled patios, this
enchanting coastal city brims with history and art. Conveniently built
for exploring on foot, downtown features a colorful mix of galleries,
boutiques, restaurants, elegant heritage buildings, lush green spaces,
and public monuments paying homage to the city's proud role as the
Birthplace of Confederation. Your ship sails at 6:30pm. (B/L/D)

September 17, 2025 - Sydney, Nova Scotia

You'll arrive in **Sydney**, on **Cape Breton Island** this morning at **9am**. The heart of Sydney is its waterfront, a great place to stroll, watch a busker and enjoy the views, which include the **world's largest fiddle**, built to honor Cape Breton's musical talent. Nearby, the quaint village of **Baddeck** is home to the **Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site** honoring the inventor of the telephone - a must see! The **Fortress of Louisbourg**, founded by the French in 1713, features massive stone walls making it one of the largest fortifications in North America, and meticulously restored to appear just as it was back in the 1740s. The Quest sails from Sydney at **6pm**. (B/L/D)

Sept. 18, 2025 - Saint-Pierre, St Pierre & Miquelon, France
Perched just off the southern coast of Canada's Newfoundland, the little
city of Saint-Pierre in the French islands of St. Pierre et
Miquelon, where you'll dock from 8am to 3pm, lets you step onto
French soil without ever leaving North America! Its Gallic flair is seen

everywhere, from **decadent pastries** and fine French wines to tricolor flags and **boutique shops** lining narrow roads. This **faraway slice of France** in these charming and quirky islands even has its own time zone! You can also lose yourself in the **enchanting countryside**, whether exploring the rocky coastline on a birding tour or hiking into the rich interior. Each island offers its own terrain and scenic vistas, perfect both for lovers of nature and of all things French! (B/L/D)

September 19, 2025 - Cap-Aux-Meules, Magdalen Is, Quebec Today you'll tender in from 9am to 6pm to the town of Cap-Aux-Meules in Quebec's remote Magdalen Islands ("Îles de la Madeleine" in French), a small archipelago in the Gulf of St. Lawrence. A tranquil fishing village on Grindstone Island, Cap-Aux-Meules' gentle landscape is punctuated by lighthouses and its two "Battered Pillars" confronting the sea. You can enjoy fresh lobster here, or partake in local specialties ranging from beer to essential oils. (B/L/D)

September 20, 2025 - One More Great Sea Day on the Quest

Spend this second and last sea day however suits you best, perhaps having a blissful treatment at **Sanctum Spa**, staying ship shape in the **fitness center**, or lounging the day away on the relaxing pool deck. In the evening, you can delight in inspired Italian cuisine at **Aqualina**, or savor the classic steakhouse experience at **Prime C**. You'll also find enticing evening entertainment, from the lively shows at the **Cabaret Lounge** to more intimate musical performances in the cozy **Living Room**. (B/L/D) **September 21, 2025 ~ Québec City, Québec**

You'll dock at **Québec City** today from **9am** to **8pm**. Founded in 1608, over 400 years of European presence left a priceless heritage that makes this charming city so captivating! Strolling to nearby **Old Québec**, designated a World Heritage treasure, is a must - wander the cobblestone streets lined with centuries-old buildings and mansard-

roofed houses, while visiting boutiques, galleries and antique shops begging to be explored! The **Plains of Abraham**, site of many clashes between the French and British, is today Québec City's equivalent to New York's Central Park. And you might also want to follow the enticing aromas wafting from **European-style bistros**! (B/L/D)

September 22, 2025 ~ Trois-Rivières, Quebec

Today finds you docked at the relatively obscure port of **Trois-Rivières** from **8am** to **6pm**. The **city's namesake three rivers** comprise the two fingers of the Saint-Maurice River flowing into the St. Lawrence. With its **pretty riverside setting**, this inviting city offers historic and cultural sites, delightful restaurants, museums and a lively downtown, all attractively nestled on its scenic waterfront! (B/L/D)

September 23, 2025 - A Fond Farewell to Canada!


