December 1 2024 - Your Journey Begins! Today, you'll board your international flight to Budapest, Hungary!

December 2, 2024 - Board the AmaBella in Budapest!

After arriving in Budapest, you'll transfer to board the graceful AmaBella! This stunning 161-passenger ship is filled with all the AMA amenities you've come to expect, from free internet access and first-run Hollywood movies to beautifully-decorated staterooms. After unpacking for your 7 nights cruising the Danube, enjoy your Welcome Dinner! You may also take advantage of your free evening to go out and discover this great city as the ship moors here overnight. You might sample delicious local specialties at one of Budapest's grand cafés, or simply go exploring on your own, perhaps to shop the unique Christmas Markets or simply stroll the festively decorated streets. December 3, 2024 - Budapest's Dazzling Markets and Sail Away! Home to several **UNESCO World Heritage Sites**, including the **Buda Castle** quarter in Castle Hill and **Heroes' Square**, your **Budapest** walking tour explores highlights of both the **Buda** (hilly) and the **Pest** (flat) sides of the river. As an alternative, you can hike to **Castle Hill**, walking along Fishermen's Bastion to take in all the city's iconic sites. In the afternoon, you'll visit **Vorosmarty Square**, the oldest, richest and most spectacular of all the Christmas Markets in Budapest. Later in the day, you'll enjoy a **scenic sail away** from Budapest to begin your **cruise of the Romantic Danube**! (B/L/D)

December 4, 2024 - Bratislava, Slovakia and on to Vienna!

This morning you'll visit Bratislava, Slovakia. Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava certainly has earned the title **"Coronation City of Kings,"** as you'll discover during your walking tour. You'll also have an opportunity to visit Bratislava's charming **Christmas market**. Or join a

special **"Tastes of Slovakia" tour**. For a more active adventure, hike up to **Bratislava Castle** for magnificent views of the city. You'll arrive later in Vienna, with a free evening to explore on your own. (B/L/D)

December 5, 2024 - Delightful Treasures of Vienna, Austria!

The **"City of Waltzes,"** legendary home to Mozart and Strauss, offers a treasure trove of gems just waiting to be discovered. Join a tour showcasing its regal splendors, including the majestic **Opera House** and the former **Imperial Palace of the Habsburgs**, before exploring Vienna's iconic and historic city center. For a more active adventure, you can join a guided bike ride through Vienna. Cap the day off with a fabulous **"Vienna by Night" Christmas Markets** tour visiting the beautifully decorated markets in this magnificent city. (B/L/D)

December 6, 2024 - Weissenkirchen, the Wachau Valley & Melk! After reaching **Weissenkirchen**, you'll face a tempting choice of excursions. You can embark on a walking tour of **Dürnstein** where you'll taste some of the village's **distinctive wines**. Or visit a local boutique to sample Dürnstein's **special apricot treats**, including jams and chocolates. For a more active adventure, you might take a guided bike tour from Weissenkirchen to **Melk**. If you're not biking to Melk, you'll sail instead through the UNESCO-designated **Wachau Valley** to Melk, where you'll visit its magnificent **Benedictine Abbey**. (B/L/D)

December 7, 2024 - Linz & Cesky Krumlov, or Salzburg, Austria! Linz is famed as both the **city of Christmas crèches** and the everpopular **Linzer torte**! Here you'll have a choice of three excursions. The first is a morning walking tour through **Linz's old city center** and past the **Mozart House**, where he composed the Linz Symphony in only three days, before visiting **Linz's Christmas Markets**. Or you might go on a guided bike tour through Linz, through the city's famed **"Culture Mile"** and also along the Danube. Or go on a **full-day visit to Salzburg** where you'll enjoy a walking tour of the UNESCO- designated **Old Town**, with its magnificent cathedral and breathtaking **Christmas Markets**. In the afternoon, for those not on the Salzburg excursion, you'll visit the **charming Czech mountain town of Cesky Krumlov** and explore its dazzling Christmas Markets. (B/L/D)

December 8, 2024 - Passau, Germany and on to Vilshofen!

December 9, 2024 - One Last Christmas Market — in Munich! After breakfast and disembarkation this morning, you'll travel southwest to **Munich**. Here at the city's central **Marienplatz** you'll have a few hours to explore and shop at its **famous Christmas Market** with lunch on your own near the iconic **Munich Clocktower**.
