It was in 1943 that the Ryman became the **beloved home to the Grand Ole Opry**, showcasing every Country and Western star from around the world. Later on, you'll get some free time to explore downtown Nashville's **colorful main street, Broadway**, famous for old-time music "honky-tonks" like **Tootsie's Orchid Lounge** where many country music artists got their start. This evening you'll enjoy Gaylord Opryland's celebrated **"Country Christmas Dinner Show,"** a joyful night of **classic and original holiday music**, plus your favorite country hits, performed by award-winning country performers featuring **Terri Clark**, and paired with a festive meal crafted by the Gaylord's award winning chefs!

December 5, 2025 - Resort Fun / Showboat / Grand Ole Opry!
