The Company's culture is defined by its corporate values of high standards of soundness, profitability, service, professionalism, integrity, and citizenship. We believe that operating sustainably benefits our many different stakeholders. The following section summarizes some of the Company's recent accomplishments with respect to environmental and social practices.

## Engagement & Belonging

The Company is committed to fostering, cultivating and preserving a culture of engagement and belonging with its associates. It is committed to including, integrating and serving individuals who represent different groups as defined by race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, age, disability, socioeconomic and family status, political affiliation, and national origin.

This commitment can be seen throughout the Company, from its associates to its community outreach efforts. The Company's associates bring a variety of backgrounds, perspectives, and experiences that are reflective of the communities and customers the Company serves. The unique capabilities and talents that its associates invest in their work represent a significant part of not only the Company's culture but its reputation and achievements as well. In 2025, its workforce, from senior officers to tellers, was 51% minority and 75% female.

Newly built and, depending upon the remodel focus, remodeled banking centers are constructed with:

- ◆ Energy efficient windows with low E insulated glass.
- ◆ LED lighting.
- ◆ Energy Star appliances.
- ◆ Insulated HVAC ductwork, controlled ventilation, and programmable thermostats.
- ◆ Occupancy sensors for lighting control.
- ◆ Programmable energy management systems for exterior lighting.
- ◆ Continuous insulation on walls and roof.
- ◆ Minimum R38 roof insulation and R21 wall insulation.
- ◆ Reflective white/light colored roofing materials.
- ◆ Greenguard certified carpets and low VOC adhesives.
- ◆ Use of LEVEL-certified furnishings for responsible manufacturing and sustainable materials.
- ◆ Electric heating and hot water heaters instead of gas appliances.

During the last five years, the Company constructed or remodeled at least 24 banking centers with these environmentally friendly features.

Further, in 2025, the Company's recycling efforts:....

- ◆ Saved 3,067,825 kilowatts of energy.
- ◆ Saved 5,237,750 gallons of water.
- ◆ Saved 44,895 pounds of pollutants from being emitted into the atmosphere.
- ◆ Kept 2,469 cubic yards of waste from landfills.
- ◆ Saved 12,720 trees.
- ◆ Saved 6,734 barrels of oil.
- ◆ Salvaged computers and hardware to avoid landfills.

THROUGH COMMUNITY GIVING AND SPONSORSHIPS, IN 2025 THE COMPANY:



Donated more than **\$4.1 million** to over **4,741 charitable community** events and organizations across Texas and Oklahoma.



Was recognized for its partnership with local non-profits in applying for **matched grant funding** from the Federal Home Loan Bank of Dallas.



Made nearly **\$167.5 million** in new Community Reinvestment Act investments and maintained over **\$513.5 million** in such investments for the year.



Made over **\$881.0 million** in Community Reinvestment Act (community development) loans.



Supported housing efforts in low-income communities by providing over **238 home loans** for a total of more than **\$55 million** in loan funding through the Company's Home Ownership Possibilities Program.

Served in over **120 leadership roles** with community-based organizations accumulating over **4,747 in-service hours**; and
