April 11, 2027 - Your Adventure Begins!

Today you'll board your international overnight flight to **Athens**, beginning the trip of a lifetime to the **hidden gems of Greece!**

April 12 and 13, 2027 - Two Nights in Athens, Greece

Welcome to **Athens**, the historic heart of **Western civilization** for four millennia! Upon your arrival, a **TRIPS representative** will greet you and assist with checking into your hotel, where you can enjoy **breakfasts** on a **scenic rooftop**. April 15, 2027 - Syros, Greece

For a change of pace, visit **Ano Syros**, a medieval **Venetian-founded** hilltop village with whitewashed houses and winding alleys, or lounge by the crystal-blue sea with a refreshing cocktail. Don't forget to indulge in local **loukoumi**, the

quintessential accompaniment to Greek coffee! You're docked here between **8am** and **6pm**. (B/L/D)

April 16, 2027 - Volos, Greece

Welcome to **Volos**, one of Greece's most stunning coastal gems! You have over twelve hours to explore a city where history meets modern energy. Whether you're admiring the local churches, hitting the **shops on Ermou Street**, or soaking up the atmosphere at a seaside café, Volos will make you feel like a local. Looking for a bucket-list thrill? Head inland to **Meteora**. Just two hours away, these '**sky-high**' **rock pillars** and **centuries-old monasteries** create a **dramatic, breathtaking skyline** that looks like something out of a dream! You'll be here from **7:30am** to **8pm**. (B/L/D)

April 17 and 18, 2027 - Two Days in Thessaloniki, Greece

Arrive in Thessaloniki at **8am on the 17th**, docking overnight until **2pm on the 18th** in a city where Aegean breezes whisper stories of old. As Greece's vibrant northern capital, Thessaloniki is a breathtaking tapestry of Roman, Byzantine, and Ottoman history set against a bustling, modern seaside. **Stroll the scenic promenade** to the **iconic White Tower**, or journey to nearby **Vergina** to explore the awe-inspiring **Museum of the Royal Tombs of Aigai**. With its lively café culture, tantalizing local cuisine, and sun-drenched, palm-fringed shoreline, this city offers a dynamic, refreshing escape. (B/L/D)

April 19, 2027 - Chios, Greece

Step into a living fairytale on **Chios**, where 12 hours (**8am** to **8pm**) feel like a journey through time. Wander the maze-like stone alleys of **Mesta**, a perfectly preserved Byzantine fortress village, and marvel at the intricate, black-and-white 'xysta' patterns adorning the walls of **Pyrgi**. Explore the **UNESCO-listed Nea Moni**, home to breathtaking 11th-century mosaics, before indulging in the unique, fragrant **taste of local mastic**, harvested nowhere else on Earth. As the sun sets, relax at a seaside taverna with fresh, locally caught seafood, where you are welcomed not as a tourist, but as family. (B/L/D)

April 20, 2027 - Kusadasi (Ephesus), Turkey

Arrive in the **Turkish** coastal town of **Kusadasi** for a full day of exploration (**8am to 10pm**). Step back in time with a visit to the nearby **ruins of Ephesus**. Once a major ancient Greek city, it was home to the **legendary Temple of Artemis** - one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Having been destroyed and rebuilt across centuries, the site now offers a **wealth of archaeological wonders** that highlight its pivotal role in early Christianity. Follow the footsteps of **Saint Paul** and **Saint John**, who famously challenged the locals to spread the Gospel throughout the region. Today, you can explore sacred sites like the **House of the Virgin Mary**, believed to be the final residence of Mary, and the **Basilica of St. John**, alongside architectural marvels such as the **Library of Celsus** built in 117 AD and the **Gate of Augustus**. April 21, 2027 - Patmos, Greece

From **8am to 6pm** today, you'll dock at the island of **Patmos**, known as the "**Jerusalem of the Aegean**." This sacred island is where **Saint John** authored the **Book of Revelation** within the Holy Cave of the Apocalypse. Since the 11th century, this cave - bearing the etched fingerprints of the Saint - has served as a sanctuary for the devout. High above, the **Monastery of Saint John the Theologian**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, **dominates the Chora skyline** with its fortress-like presence. Once a site of Roman exile, Patmos is now a radiant gem where spiritual legacy, whitewashed architecture, and serene beaches create a uniquely peaceful and authentic Greek experience. (B/L/D)

April 22, 2027 - Paros, Greece

Today, your cruise ship will anchor in **Paros** from **8am to 4pm**. Known as the "**Jewel of the Cyclades**," this island captures the quintessential Greek daydream - **pristine turquoise waters**, historic sites, and **world-class wineries** - without the intense crowds of its neighbors. Spend your morning lost in the **whitewashed alleys** of

Naoussa, a charming fishing village where colorful boats bob alongside chic boutiques and waterfront cafes. In the capital of **Parikia**, don't miss the fascinating Panagia Ekatonpiliani - "**Church of 100 Doors**." Legend has it that the **4th-century Byzantine church** contains 99 known doors, plus a secret hidden door. Before returning to the ship, settle into a shaded taverna along the charming streets of old town to **savor local delicacies** like **saganaki**, gyros and **fresh seafood** paired with a crisp Paros white wine. Whether you're lounging on a golden beach or exploring ancient ruins, Paros offers an authentic slice of island paradise. (B/L/D)

April 22 and 23, 2027 - Overnight Stay in Mykonos, Greece

Following a scenic sail from Paros, the Onward docks at lovely **Mykonos** on the **22nd at 7pm**, staying overnight until **6pm on the 23rd**. This iconic island charms with whitewashed buildings, blue-domed churches, and signature windmills. Don't miss the **Windmills, 16th-century landmarks** that overlook the sea and are the island's most iconic photo spot. Along the romantic waterfront, you'll find **Little Venice** with colorful houses with overhanging balconies kissing the waves. You have ample time to explore **Chora**, a pedestrian only maze of narrow alleys, **vibrant blue doors** and blooming bougainvillea. Originally designed to **confuse pirates**, more than one visitor has been flummoxed by the winding streets! You might also take a short boat trip to the **Delos**, the **mythical birthplace of Apollo** and one of Greece's most important archaeological ruins. (B/L/D)

April 24, 2027 - Welcome Back to Athens, Greece!

The Onward returns to **Athens'** port of Piraeus at **5am**. After breakfast and disembarkation, you'll transfer to the airport for your flight home. **Memories of your Hidden Gems of Greece cruise/tour will last a lifetime!** (B)
