## Itinerary

### June 15, 2027 - Off to Paris, France!

Today you board your overnight flight bound for Paris, The City of Light!

### June 16, 2027 - Bateaux Mouches / Board the Amadeus Diamond!

On arriving in **Paris**, you'll be met and assisted to your motorcoach for a **panoramic tour of Paris highlights**, followed by your special excursion cruising the Seine on a famed **Bateaux Mouches Seine River boat** with amazing views of Paris while enjoying a boxed sandwich lunch onboard! Later, you'll board the **AMADEUS Diamond for 7 luxurious nights** with embarkation starting at **4pm**. Once on board, toast to the journey ahead with a **welcome cocktail** followed by a **Welcome Dinner!** As night falls, settle in for a radiant evening **cruising past stunningly illuminated landmarks** as you sail away from Paris at **8pm!** (L/D)

### June 17, 2027 - Conflans & Auvers - Van Gogh's Last Home!

Docking at **Conflans** this afternoon from **1:30pm to 5pm**, you can wander through the historic heart of **Conflans**, with its narrow, winding streets, half-timbered houses, and charming squares. Or you might want to visit **Auberge Ravoux** in the heart of **Auvers-sur-Oise**, famed for the Impressionist painters who once lived there, including **Cézanne** and **Pissarro**. It was also the last home of artist **Vincent van Gogh**, whose spirit still lingers in the meticulously preserved attic rooms at the **Ravoux Inn** where he lived and died. His last 70 days spent here were astonishingly prolific, as Van Gogh painted more than 70 works just before his death. Or perhaps you'll prefer to enjoy the exquisite architecture of the **Chateau Saint-Germain-en-Laye**, along with its museum and gardens. (B/L/D)

### June 18, 2027 - Rouen - The Heart of Normandy!

This morning you'll dock from **8am to 5:30pm** in **Rouen**, the historic capital of Normandy. **Monet** was inspired to paint more than 30 canvases here in his **Notre-Dame** series. You can see the Place du Vieux Marché where in 1431 **Joan of Arc** was convicted and burned at the stake, as well as the **Medieval Quarter** and **Great Clock**. Or maybe you'll explore the historic center of this "**city of a hundred bell towers**" that's a maze of half-timbered houses and churches. The **Museum of Fine Arts in Rouen** contains one of the best impressionist collections in France with

works by **Renoir**, **Degas** and of course **Monet**. You might also visit the **Le Pressoir d'Or estate** for a tasting of cider and regional specialties, or explore **Lyons-la-Forêt**, one of France's most beautiful villages. As Normandy is a culinary delight, be sure to stop at one of Rouen's small confectioners to watch local caramels and chocolates being made, or a cheese shop offering Camembert and other Norman cheeses. (B/L/D)

### June 19, 2027 - Overnight in Seaside Le Havre / Lovely Honfleur!

Arriving at **Le Havre** at **3:30am**, you'll enjoy the entire day and evening here, as you're docked until **9am** the following day. You might simply explore on your own the fascinating UNESCO-designated seaport of **Le Havre**. On this lengthy port stop, you might also elect to visit **Honfleur**, one of the most beloved towns in France with its picturesque harbor, quaint streets and timber-framed houses. Honfleur is especially celebrated for the changing light on the Seine estuary that inspired Impressionist painters **Courbet**, **Monet**, **Boudin** and many others. You might also visit the delicious **Pays d'Auge** region of Normandy, where apple cider, Calvados and pommeau outrank French wine. Or you can even walk along the cliff paths of **Étretat's dramatic white chalk formations**, taking in panoramic coastal views. But you'll surely want to return to the ship later for a **special onboard evening of French chansons!** (B/L/D)

### June 20, 2027 - Included Private Normandy D-Day Beaches Tour!

You'll set out this morning from Le Havre with your experienced licensed tour guide on an included excursion to the **US Sector of the Normandy D-Day beaches**. This intimate in-depth tour takes you to **Pointe du Hoc**, **Omaha Beach**, and the **American Cemetery** and Visitor Center. You'll visit the **Ranger Monument** where "Rudder's Rangers" achieved one of the war's greatest feats, scaling Pointe du Hoc's 90-foot-cliff under intense German gunfire and securing the site as part of the heroic Allied victory. You'll stop for a sandwich lunch during your visit to **Omaha Beach**, where the future of France and Europe were at stake on the 6th of June, 1944 when US troops landed with very little going as planned, as 3,000 troops lost their lives that day. The citizens of France granted the cemetery for all eternity to the United States, and here you'll see the **vast panorama of more than nine thousand white marble gravestones**

perfectly lined up across a field overlooking Omaha beach. The soldiers who died during the **D-Day Landing** and the **Battle of Normandy** lie at rest here, and you'll surely discover that your special visit on this day will be **among the most moving experiences** of your life. Afterward, you'll return to your ship that will have docked in **Caudebec-en-Caux** at **3:30pm**.



**June 21, 2027 - Les Andelys and Vernon - Monet's Giverny Home!**  
At lovely **Les Andelys** from **8 to 9am**, you can enjoy a walk along the river with beautiful views of the Seine Valley's dramatic white cliffs, centuries-old half-timbered houses, and the hilltop ruins of **Château Gaillard**. Situated on the chalk cliffs high above the Seine, this former stronghold of **Richard the Lionheart** changed hands many times during the Hundred Years' War. You might also visit **Claude Monet's home in Giverny** and stroll through the iconic water lily gardens. Lunch is served

on board in **Vernon**, where the Diamond is docked from **11:30am to 1:30pm**. In the afternoon before the ship docks once again in **Mantes-La-Jolie** from **5:30pm to 6:30pm**, you might explore **Château de Malmaison**, Empress Joséphine's elegant estate, or perhaps take a culinary tour of **Ferme des Ruelles**, a historic cider farm, followed by a tasting tour at **La Brasserie de l'Apocalypse** brewery. (B/L/D)

**June 22, 2027 - Overnight in Paris - The City of Light!**

After docking at **3:30am** this morning, you'll have the **full day and evening free** to enjoy this fabulous city, exploring enchanting Paris exactly as you wish! You might ascend the great **Eiffel Tower**, a global icon of France, or perhaps view the recent restoration of **Notre-Dame Cathedral** following its catastrophic 2019 fire. You might stroll along the **Champs Elysees** and see the famed **Arc de Triomphe** commissioned by Napoleon in 1806. There's also historic **Montmartre**, lined with the narrow hilly streets made famous by not only by its resident artists, but also as the setting for the classic film "**An American in Paris.**" (B/L/D)

**June 23, 2027 - Farewell to Paris!**

After breakfast on the ship, you'll disembark and transfer to the airport for your flight home. **You'll carry home with you unforgettable memories of Paris to Normandy on the Seine with Amadeus!** (B)
