

# Salem Haunted Happening & Jack O'Lantern Spectacular

Step back in time to 1692 for a dramatic history lesson using stage sets with life-size figures, lighting, and narration to experience this dramatic witch hunt that struck fear and terror into the hearts of the Salem townspeople and ultimately led to the court trials and executions of many men and women! Enjoy lunch on your own along Pickering Wharf, Salem's quaint, harbor-side village featuring a variety of shops, boutiques, and restaurants. Then enjoy a performance of "Cry Innocent: The People vs. Bridget Bishop." The year is 1692. Bridget Bishop has been accused of witchcraft, and the audience sits on the Puritan jury. They hear the historical testimonies and cross-

examination of the witnesses and decide the verdict! Step into Salem's most storied seaside mansion as we tour the House of Seven Gables—an atmospheric treasure that helped inspire Nathaniel Hawthorne and still feels like a page from a darkly romantic New England tale. Enjoy a guided mansion experience with a costumed-style historical interpreter as you explore nine fascinating rooms and "walk through time," from an early kitchen with a grand hearth to later period spaces shaped by generations of lives, legends, and lore. The rest of the day and evening is at leisure to enjoy and explore the variety of events the Salem Haunted Happenings has to offer, such as spell castings, ghostly walking tours, the annual Salem Psychic Fair and Witches Market featuring the Witch City's most gifted Psychics, an emporium of magical gifts, meet real practicing Witches and even make an appointment with one of Salems talented psychic readers as you delve into your destiny! This evening, gather for dinner at one of Salem's great restaurants.

**Overnight: Northshore Coastal Region, MA (B,D)**

**Oct 26 | Rockport, Gloucester, Hammond Castle & Haunted Walking Tour of Salem.** After breakfast, meet your local Step-On Guide and enjoy a guided tour of the picturesque village of Rockport, with colorful fishermen's shacks, house art studios, trinket shops, and the famous fishing shack on Bradley Wharf, known as "Motif #1", one of the most painted buildings in the USA and a symbol on the Massachusetts U.S. postal stamp. Continue to Gloucester, America's oldest seaport with its working harbor filled with lobster boats and trawlers, and home to the famous movie, "The Perfect Storm." Enjoy a planned lunch at one of the area's famous restaurants. This afternoon, enjoy a picture stop at the famous Gloucester Fisherman's Memorial and a tour of Hammond Castle Museum, a unique treasure on the coast of Gloucester,



Massachusetts. Constructed between 1926 and 1929 by inventor John Hays Hammond, Jr., the structure is modeled on a medieval castle. It was custom-built to encompass his private collection of artifacts spanning from ancient Rome through the Renaissance. This evening, return to Salem for a ghostly Haunted walking tour. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own in Salem before returning to the hotel for the evening.

**Oct 27 | New England Farm, Lizzie Borden House & Jack O'Lantern Spectacular.** Enjoy breakfast before setting off for another fun-filled autumn day in New England and visit an authentic New England farm, where crisp autumn air, rows of apple trees, and pumpkin-filled fields set the scene for the perfect fall outing. Stroll through the enchanting displays at Roger Williams Park Zoo, where thousands of intricately carved pumpkins illuminate the night, accompanied by a musical journey spanning the 1860s through today. This dazzling and immersive experience is one of Rhode Island's most magical autumn traditions. As the day draws to a close, gather with your fellow travelers for a special farewell dinner, included this evening, to celebrate the wonderful memories made along your journey
